

Domestic Abuse Awareness – Full Day

Who is this course aimed for

This full day awareness course is aimed at professionals and volunteers working in the Violence against Women, Domestic Abuse and Sexual Violence sector, Local Authority, Housing, Health, Police and other services working in a public facing role.

This course builds on our ½ day course providing delegates with further, in depth knowledge and understanding of Domestic Abuse. Delegates will have an increased understanding, enabling them to recognise signs of abuse, understand the impact on victims and survivors and respond to disclosures of abuse appropriately. Skills practice includes using the (DASH RIC - Domestic abuse stalking and Harassment risk indicator checklist) and attending a mock MARAC (multi agency risk assessment conference) to share information.

Learning outcomes

- Define domestic abuse.
- Understand and summarise the prevalence, extent and severity of domestic abuse.
- Explain the impact of domestic abuse on victims, survivors and the wider community.
- Understand good practice in relation to supporting individuals affected by domestic abuse.
