

Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) – Half Day

This training will enable individuals to recognise the signs of FGM and give practitioners the confidence to know where to signpost those affected for support, as well as responding to any disclosures appropriately.

- Understand the legality of FGM in the UK
- Have an insight into how someone undergoing FGM may be affected and how to recognise the signs
