

Safeguarding – Full Day

Who is this course aimed for

This full day course is for professionals and volunteers working with children, young people and adults to provide an all Wales standardised approach to Safeguarding in line with the Social Services and Wellbeing Act (Wales) 2014. The course increases individuals knowledge to fully understand their role in safeguarding individuals at risk of abuse, harm and neglect. The course is based on the Social Care Framework developed by Social Care Wales 'Induction to Safeguarding' The course explains how to keep ourselves and others safe, how to establish and maintain a professional approach with individuals and external agencies and provides an understanding of the legislation and reporting framework in Wales.

Learning outcomes

This training will give the opportunity for participants to:

- Know own role in relation to safeguarding adults and children and young people from harm, abuse and neglect.
- Understand how individuals are protected from harm, abuse and neglect.
- Know how to recognise different types of harm, abuse and neglect.
- Understand the legal framework in Wales.
